Culture section:

Study the culture reading on p. C32-3. Be able to define the words that are italicized. Review the quiz we did over this reading.

Greetings:

Know how to greet someone formally and familiarly. Also know how to tell them goodbye.

Alphabet:

Be prepared to spell something out. I will have a section where I will spell a word and you must listen and write it. Study the alphabet sheet.

Conversation:

Know how to ask what someone's name is and know how to answer what your name is, what his/her name is, etc. Know how to introduce others.

Geography:

Know how to say the names of countries in Spanish. Know how to ask "Where are you from?" and be able to answer it.

**Remember that answering a "Yes" or "No" question negatively requires the word "no" twice.

Ex: ¿Eres de Colombia? (Are you from Colombia?)

No, no soy de Colombia. Soy de los Estados Unidos. (No, I'm not from Colombia. I'm from the United States.)

Numbers:

Know how to use and write out numbers in Spanish. You will also need to read the *Expansion* portion at the top of page 17 in your book.

más = plus **menos** = minus

Days of the Week/Weather:

Study your days of the week and the weather conditions. Make sure you know the phrases that come with them.
