

Spanish 2 & 3 Study Guide

Lección preliminar

Vocabulary:

Make sure you study your vocab and know all the words and phrases for this vocab section. Use your vocab sheet to help you. This includes, food, descriptions, phrases, verbs, etc.

¿Quiénes son?

Be able to identify people using the correct phrases.

Definite and Indefinite Articles:

Make sure you know which are definite articles and indefinite articles. Be able to use them correctly.

Ser:

Know what “ser” means. Be able to conjugate and use correctly.

¿Cómo son?

Be able to describe yourself and others.

Masculine vs. Feminine

Be able to differentiate masculine nouns vs. feminine nouns. Know when to use which gender, as well as be familiar with some of the exceptions to the rules. Use the chart on p. 8 to help you.

Tener:

Know what “tener” means. Be able to conjugate and use it correctly. Familiarize yourself with idiomatic expressions used with “tener”.

¿Qué te gusta hacer?

Be able to use the verb “gustar” correctly. Make sure you know which indirect object pronoun is used with it. Be able to talk about what you and others like to do.

¿Adónde van?

Be able to ask where one is going or what they are going to do. Know what the verb “ir” means and be able to conjugate it and use it correctly. Be able to use the “ir + a + place” formula and “ir + a + infinitive” formula correctly.

¿Cómo estás?

Be able to ask how someone is and be able to respond if you are asked. Know the verb “estar” and be able to conjugate it and use it correctly. Be able to differentiate when to use “ser” and when to use “estar”.

¿Qué haces?

Be able to talk about what you are doing at different times of the day. Know what the verb “hacer” means and know how to conjugate it and use it correctly. Be able to talk about what you “are going to do”.

Regular Verbs:

Be able to recognize and conjugate regular –AR, -ER, and –IR verbs.

Stem-Changing Verbs:

Be able to recognize stem-changing verbs and be able to conjugate them.
